Circulation Policy

All people wishing to borrow material from the library must be registered at any of the Northern Waters Library Service libraries. Anyone can get a card so you will be free to borrow our materials.

LOAN PERIODS & RULES:

- The loan period for books and audiobooks is three weeks.
- Movies in all formats are due in one week.
- Any materials can be renewed either online, in person or by phone for another loan period if there are no other patrons waiting for that item.
- Sometimes things like best-selling books and newly released movies will have a waiting list, so they will not be renewable.

FINES AND REPLACEMENT FOR LOST OR DAMAGED MATERIALS:

- The Drummond Public Library does not charge fines for overdue items, but we fully expect patrons to keep their loan record current and up to date.
- Other Northern Waters libraries do charge fines, so it is up to the patron to know if the library that they are borrowing an item from charges fines.
- If you do have overdue items, even though we don't charge fines, your patron record (online as well) will be blocked from use until you return, replace, or pay for your outstanding items. You may not be able to loan from other libraries until the account activity is cleared.
- Items borrowed from other libraries will have the same loan period as the Drummond Library. Being able to borrow other libraries' material is a privilege, so we expect patrons to respect this privilege by adhering to the loan rules and respect materials.
- Items lost or damaged are expected to be replaced or paid for. Our specific policy (not every library is the same) is that the item can be replaced at equal value, or paid for so it can be replaced. Your library privileges will be restored once the account is cleared.
