Teen (12-18 years) Use Policy

All patrons using the library are required to follow the Drummond Public Library's Behavior Policy. The following behaviors are not permitted in the library:

- Violence
- Excessive noise
- Disruptive public displays of affection
- Vandalism and destruction of library property

The Drummond Public Library is for reference and enrichment use. We would like all our patrons to continue to have access to all materials, programs and services. We are happy to host you as a latch key patron. Or, between school activities safe place to gather. But there are some guidelines you must follow while using our services.

Clean up after yourself and the areas that you use.

There is no food or beverages permitted at the Computer Workstations.

You have one (1) hour to use the computer for appropriate needs. If there is another patron waiting to use the computer, the first person will give up their spot Gaming is not a necessity.

Violation of any of the rules above or anything from the DPL Behavior Policy will be handled in the following way:

Patron will be asked to stop behavior.

Patron will be asked again to stop behavior and warned that they will be asked to leave if warned again.

Patron will be asked to leave the library.

Patrons may be asked to leave the library, at the discretion of any library staff member, if the situation mandates. If necessary, parents will be contacted, and you could be banned from using the library and its services.
